Vincentians response to review of Safeguarding Practice, 23 October 2014

We, the Vincentians, have today published the review of the National Board for Safeguarding Children into safeguarding practice in our Congregation. We take this opportunity to thank the members of the Board for their work.

We sincerely apologise to those who were abused by members of our Congregation and acknowledge the deep suffering of survivors and the ongoing traumatic effects of their ordeals. We will continue to strive to respond in a compassionate way to assist them in their journey towards healing.

This review deals with allegations made against 13 members of our Congregation over a fifty year period, dating back to the 1950s, 11 of whom are deceased.

The report shows that we are fully compliant with guidelines in regard to reporting and responding to all allegations and we will continue to ensure that our safeguarding procedures are thoroughly implemented; this will include the implementation of the recommendations made by the National Board. (These recommendations are listed on page 30 of the Review).

We accept the findings of the review and make a firm commitment to implement all eight recommendations.
